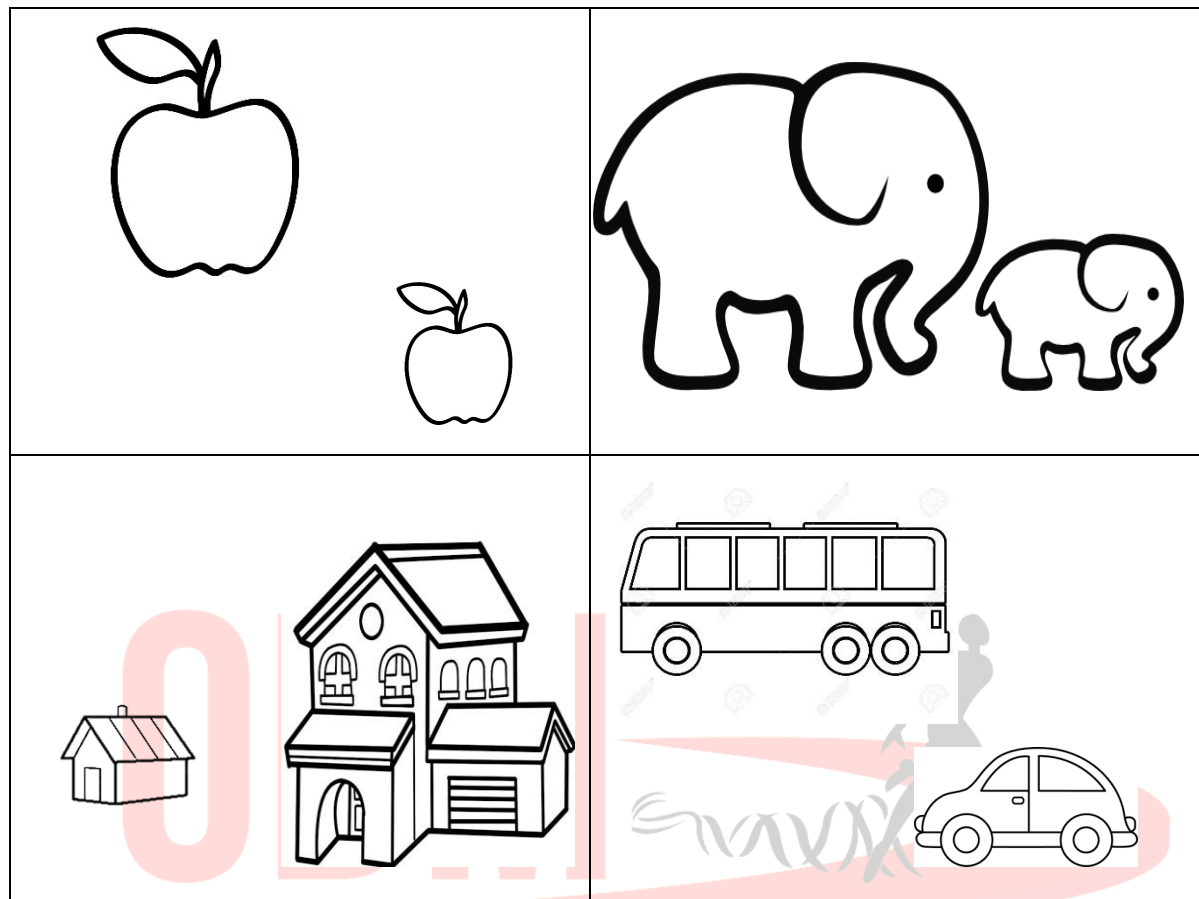


Cats love to hear the sound of the human voice, especially when their names are pronounced, so talk to your pet as much as you can.

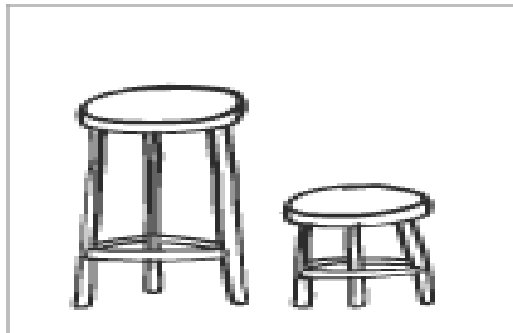
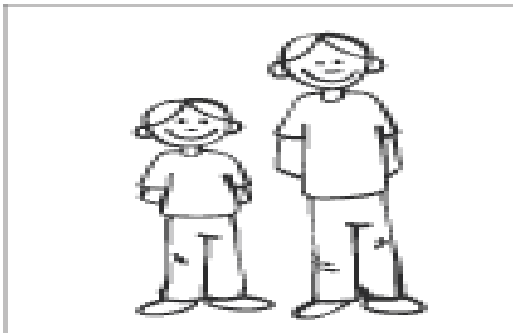
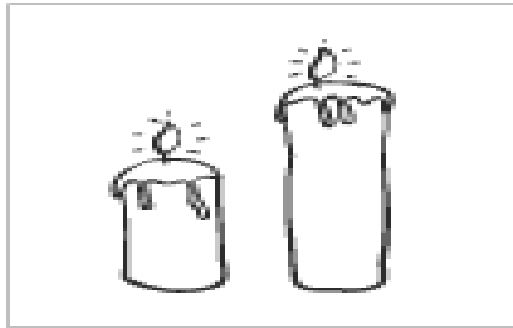
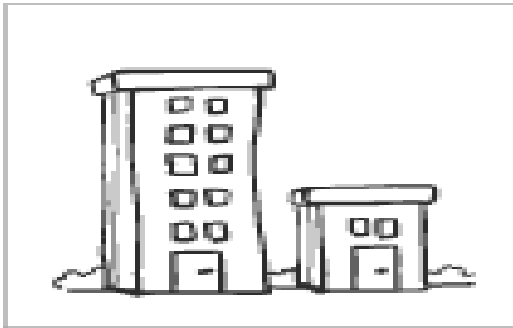


DID YOU KNOW?

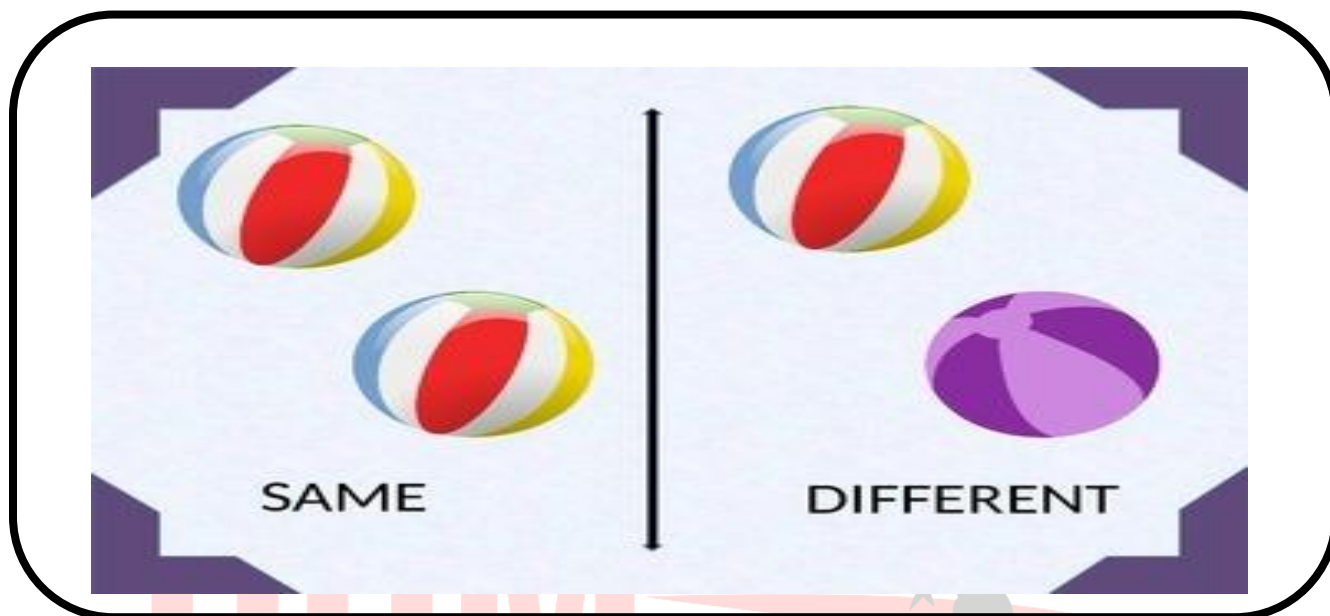
Same-Different

- In the first box all the pencils are pink in colour where as in the next box all pencils are different in colour.

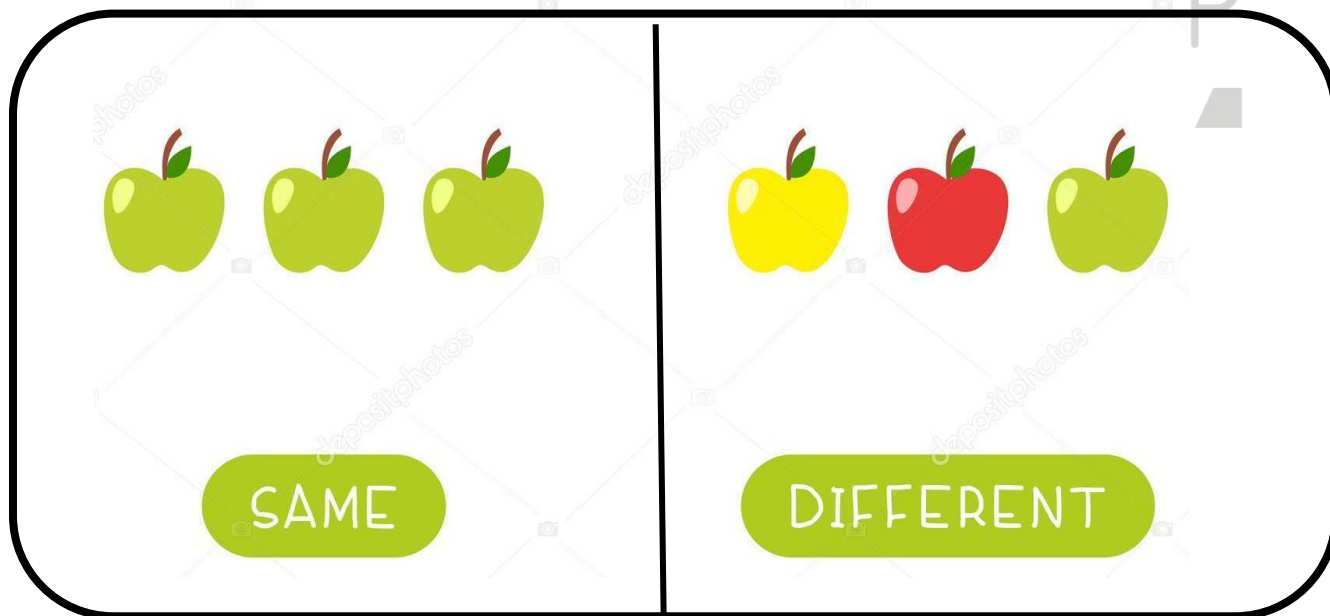




- In the left side box all the three umbrellas are same in colour, ✓ but in the right side box all three umbrellas are different in colour.
