COINS:

Coins are made of metals . In India coins worth 50 paise, 2 rupees, 1 rupee, and 10 rupees are in use now.



CURRENCY NOTE:

Notes are made of papers. In India we use 1 rupee note, 2 rupees note, 5 rupees note, 10 rupees note, 20 rupees note ,50 rupees note, 100 rupees note, 200 rupees note ,500 rupees note and 2000 rupees note.

Different types of Indian Currency Notes



Conversion of Paise to Rupees:



= 50p+50p= 100 paise

100 paise = 1 rupee

Finding the total value of coins:



₹ 22

2 rupees + 10 rupees + 10 rupees = 22 rupees



₹ 26

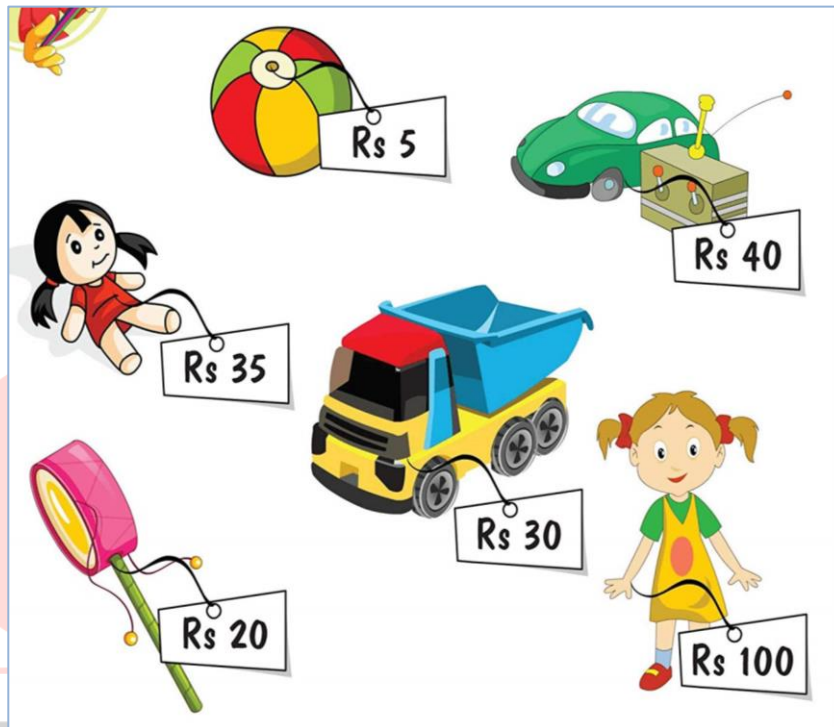
5 rupees + 20 rupees + 1 rupee = 26 rupees



₹ 35

10 rupees + 5 rupees + 10 rupees + 10 rupees = 35 rupees

Shopping: Richa and Ranya go to a toy shop and buy different toys.



Richa buys a doll and a toy truck . How much she has to pay?

Cost of doll = 100 rupees

Cost of toy truck = 30 rupees

Total cost of 2 items = 100 rupees + 30 rupees = 130 rupees.

So, she has to pay 130 rupees to the shopkeeper.

Ranya buys a ball and a toy car . How much she has to pay?

Cost of ball = 5 rupees

Cost of toy car 40 rupees

Total cost of 2 items = 5 rupees + 40 rupees = 45 rupees

So, she has to pay 45 rupees to the shopkeeper.
