STUDY NOTES

<u>Let's Learn:</u>

- Some days are warm, some days are cool and some days are rainy.
- These are ways in which we describe the weather in a place. The weather can change within a very short time.
- A day may be rainy in the morning, and then it can become sunny and clear by afternoon. When we have the same weather for a long time, it is called a season.
- > We have three main seasons in India. They are summer, monsoon and winter.

Summe<mark>r:</mark>

- The hot season is known as summer.
- The days are long and sunny. We like to wear light cotton clothes to keep ourselves cool during summer.
- We also like to drink lots of water and other cold drinks.
- March, April, May and June are the summer months.



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Monsoon:

- > The rainy season comes after the hot summer months.
- > This season is also known as the monsoon.
- The days are cloudy and it rains very often. We wear raincoats, or carry an umbrella, when we go out.
- > The rainy season occurs during the months of July, August and September.




Winter:

- The cold season is known as winter.
- Cold winds blow in winter and it may even snow in some places in the mountains.
- > The days are short and cool and the nights are long and cold.
- We wear woollen clothes to keep ourselves warm. We like to drink something hot in winter.
- November, December, January and February are the winter months.
