
Chapter- 11 Our Earth


<u>Let's Learn:</u>

- ➢ We live on the Earth.
- > The Earth is shaped like an orange-round and slightly flat at the top and at the bottom.
- > We share the Earth with plants and other animals.
- > The Earth is covered with land, water and air.



Land:

- There are different kinds of lands.
- > A large area of flat land is called a plain. Crops grow well on the plains.
- Very high land is called a hill or a mountain. Some crops like tea and coffee grow well in hilly areas.
- A large area of land that has very little water and where very few plants grow is called a desert. Many deserts are covered with sand.



Water:


- > A large part of the Earth is covered with water.
- > There is water in the oceans, rivers, lakes and ponds.
- We need water to drink, cook our food, wash our clothes and keep ourselves clean.

- It makes the water dirty.




Garbage dumped in a river
