

At a glance:

- Prepositions show us a noun's relationship to another word in the sentence. It often comes before nouns.
- Prepositions are often used to give us more information about <u>time</u>, <u>place and movement</u>.



We use preposition of time to say when something happens, happened or will happen

We use preposition of place ro say where somebody or something is.


We use preposition of movement to show the direction in which somebody or something is moving.
