{ A boy a field an elephant an hour an inkpot }

Some nouns name things you can count. Such are COUNTABLE NOUNS.
 You can use a or an before them.

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{ A shell , A tiger , A field , A forest }
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 Some nouns name things you cannot count. Such words are UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS. You cannot use a or an before them.

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{ Rain , Water , Rice }
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An is used when the next word begins with a vowel sound.(a,e,l,o,u)

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{ An apple, an umbrella, an hour }
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• When we talk about a particular noun, we use The.

The house with the blue gate is Mala's.

The cat sat on the couch.


• We use The with something that is unique or there is only one.

{ the sun/ the moon/ the internet }
