what are PREPOSITIONS?

A preposition is a word that shows the relationship between an object (**a noun or pronoun**) and other words in a sentence.

Around

Prepositions may be used to indicate position, place, direction or time.

PREPOSITIONS OF PLACE	Tells us about a place or position of a noun or pronoun.	On, in , at , beneath, beside, inside , against , behind	Example: Raghu was waiting inside the store.
PREPOSITIONS OF TIME	Show when something happens.	In , at , during, on, since, for, ago, before, until , till, during	India became independent in the year 1947.
PREPOSITIONS OF MOVEMENT OR DIRECTIONS	Shows the direction in which a noun and pronoun is moving to or from a place.	To, through, towards, over, out, across, along	I walked slowly across the road.

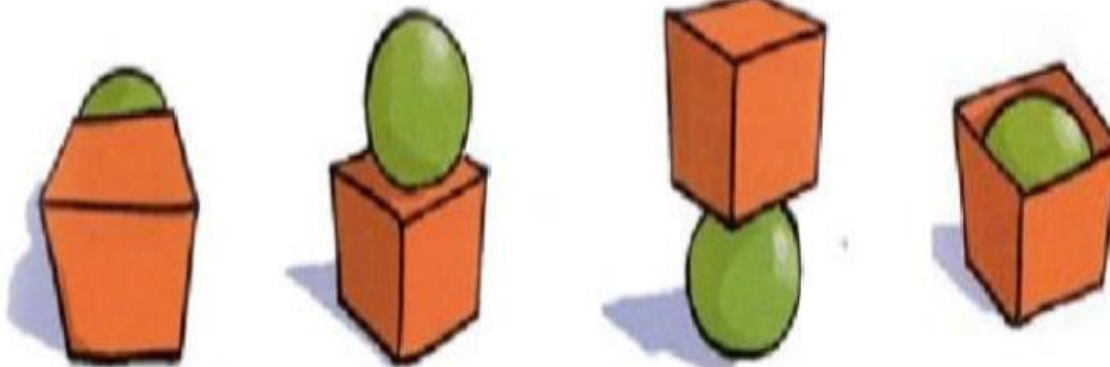
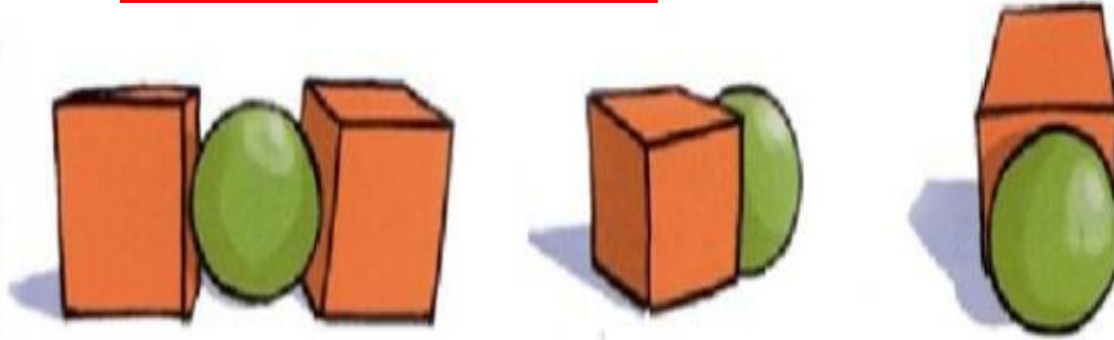
