A <u>preposition</u> is a word that shows the relationship between an object (a noun or pronoun) and other words in a sentence.



Prepositions may be used to indicate position, place, direction or time.

Tells us about a place or position of a noun or pronoun.


On, in, at, beneath, beside, inside, against, behind




Show when something happens.
