- 2) Adjectives are further divided into various types.
- 3) Adjective of Quality. It answers the question "what kind of".
- 4) Adjective of Quantity. It answers the question "how much".
- 5) Adjective of Quantity is generally used with uncountable nouns.
- 6) Adjective of Number. It answers the question "how many" and "what position".
- 7) It is also generally used with uncountable nouns.
- 8) Possessive adjective. It normally answers the question "whose".
- 9) Demonstrative adjective. It normally answers to the question "which one(s)".
- 10) Interrogative adjective. It is used to ask a question and is followed by a noun.
- 11) Distributive adjective. It refers to an individual thing or person among many.
