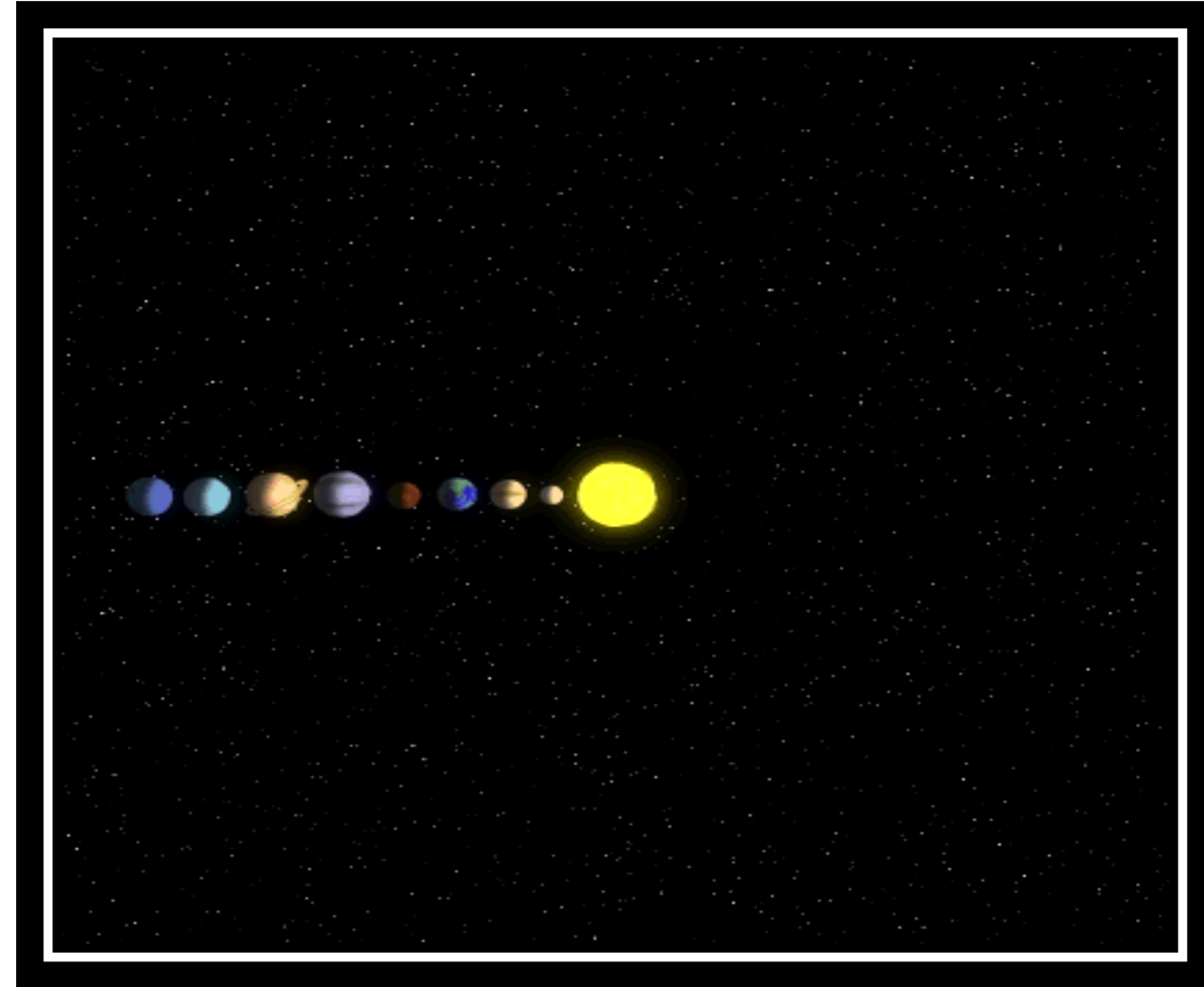

The Moon

- It is the nearest neighbor in the universe.
- Moon has many big and small holes called craters.



The Planets

- Planets are round bodies that travel around star.
- They are made of rocks or gases.
- They do not have their own heat and light.
- They get heat and light from the stars they move around.



THE EARTH


- **The Earth is the third planet from the sun.**

- 1. Universe-** The vast expanse of space that contains gas, dust, stars, planets, and other heavenly bodies
- 2. Stars-** A large ball of hot, burning gas that gives out heat and light.
- 3. Constellation-** A small group of stars that seem to form patterns in the sky.
- 4. Planet-** A heavenly body that moves around a star.
- 5. Solar System-** A group of heavenly bodies that consist of the sun and all the objects that move around it.
- 6. Satellite-** A body moving around a planet; it can be natural or human made.
- 7. Astronaut-** A person who is trained to travel in outer space .
- 8. Space shuttle-** A rocket-like aircraft in which people can travel to outer space and back.
