

- Earth is known as living planet.






NEW WORDS AND WORD MEANINGS

- 2. Stars- A large ball of hot, burning gas that gives out heat and light.
- 3. Constellation- A small group of stars that seem to form patterns in the sky.
- 4. Planet- A heavenly body that moves around a star.
- 5. Solar System- A group of heavenly bodies that consist of the sun and all the objects that move around it.
- 6. Satellite- A body moving around a planet; it can be natural or human made.
- 7. Astronaut- A person who is trained to travel in outer space.
- 8. Space shuttle- A rocket-like aircraft in which people can travel to outer space and back.
