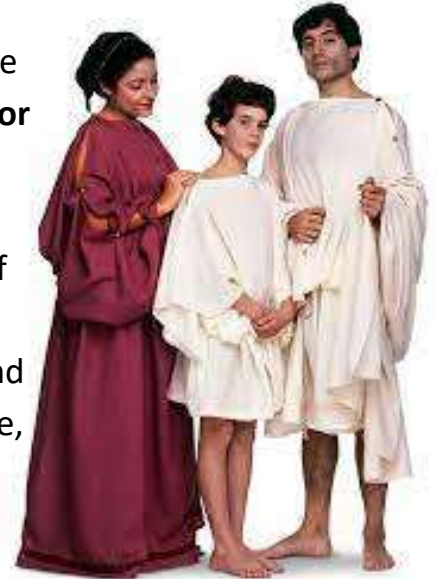
INTRODUCTION
