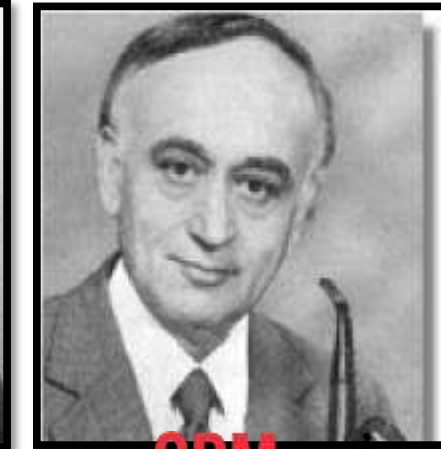

Man's goodness is a flame that can be hidden but never extinguished.

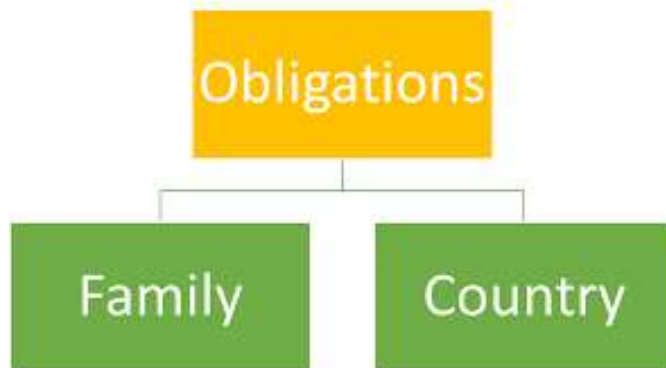
