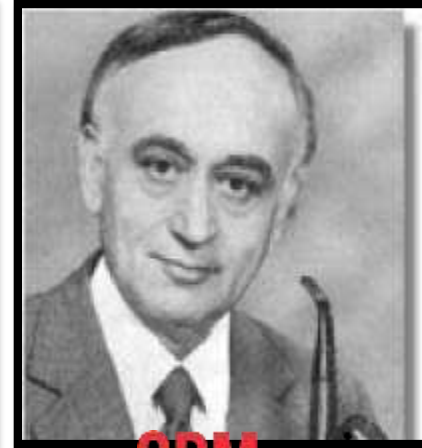

Glorious- beautiful, grand

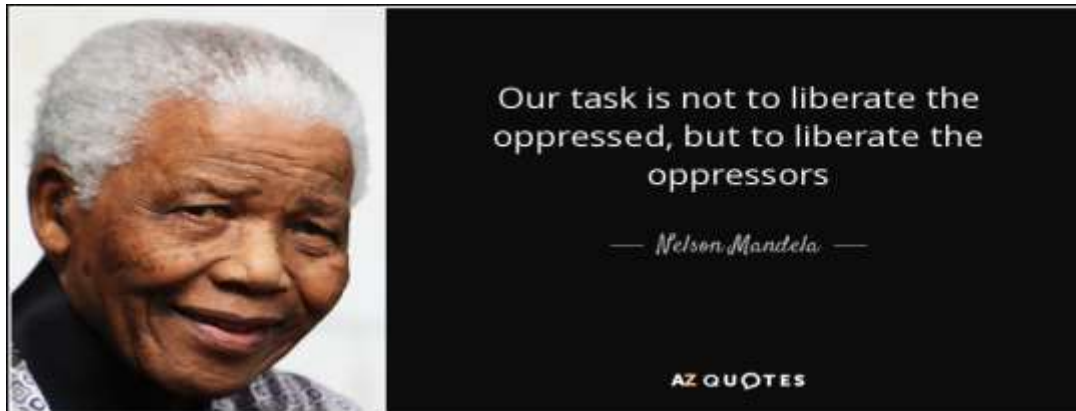
Prejudice- ill feeling
