## Plants: Living and Non-living

- A. 1. Plants that grow on land are called terrestrial plants.
  2. In desert most plants grow without leaves.
  3. A root which grows out of the soil and water to breathe is called as breathing root.
  4. A plant that grows in water is called aquatic plants.
  5. Insectivorous plants eat insects.

- B. 1. Cactus is a desert / aquatic / terrestrial plant.
  2. In marshy / desert / hilly areas the soil is clayey and sticky.
  3. Duckweed and water lettuce are underwater / fixed / floating plants.
