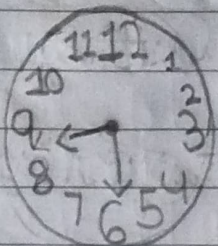
1. I go to school at 7 a.m. in the morning.2. I do my homework at 7 p.m.

A1 18 days

$$1 \text{ days} = 24 \text{ hours}$$

$$\text{So } 18 \text{ days} = 18 \times 24 = 432 \text{ hour}$$

$$\text{So, } 18 \text{ days} = 432 \text{ hour.}$$

2 11 days 20 hours

$$1 \text{ day} = 24 \text{ hours}$$

$$\text{So } 11 \text{ days} = 11 \times 24 = 264 \text{ hours}$$

$$\text{Since } 264 \text{ hours} + 20 \text{ hours} = 284 \text{ hours}$$

$$\text{So } 11 \text{ days } 20 \text{ hours} = 284 \text{ hours}$$

B

1. 8 hours

$$1 \text{ hours} = 60 \text{ minutes}$$

$$\text{So } 8 \text{ hours} = 8 \times 60 \text{ minutes} = 480 \text{ minutes}$$

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2. 20 hours 30 minutes

1 hour = 60 minutes

So 20 hours = $20 \times 60 = 1200$ minutes

Since 1200 minutes + 30 minutes = 1230 minutes.

3. 16 hours 10 minutes

1 hour = 60 minutes

So 16 hours = $16 \times 60 = 960$ minutes

Since 960 minutes + 10 minutes = 970 minutes.
