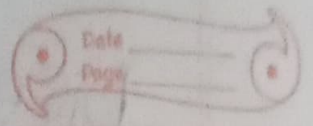

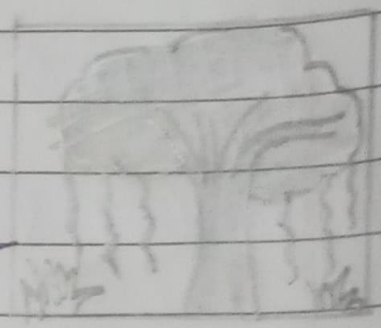

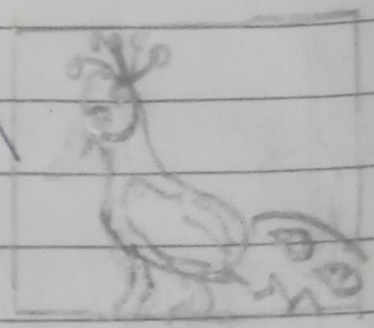

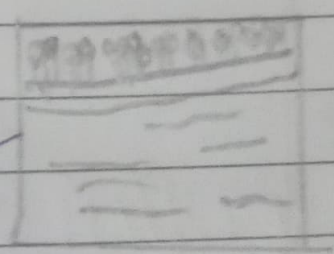
2 National Bird
