2. I do my homework at 7 9:00.

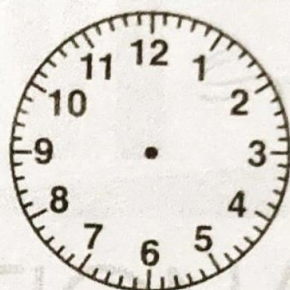
**B. What will be the time after 4 hours of the following time.**

**III. Solve :**

**A. Convert the given number of days and hours into hours.**

1. 18 days

2. 11 days 20 hours

B. Convert the given number of hours and minutes into minutes.

1. 8 hours  $1 \text{ hour} = 60 \text{ minutes}$   
 $8 \text{ hours} = 8 \times 60 \text{ minutes} = 480 \text{ minutes}$
2. 20 hours 30 minutes  $1 \text{ hour} = 60 \text{ minutes}$   
 $20 \text{ hours} = 60 \times 20 \text{ hours} = 1200$   
 $20 \text{ hours } 30 \text{ minutes} = 1200 + 30 = 1230$
3. 16 hours 10 minutes

3. 16 hours 10 minutes  
 $1 \text{ hour} = 60 \text{ minutes}$

$16 \text{ hours} = \text{END} \quad 16 \times 60 \text{ minutes} = 960 \text{ min}$

$16 \text{ hours } 10 \text{ minutes} = 960 + 10 = 970$

III Solve

4. 1 - 18 days

$1 \text{ days} = 24 \text{ hours}$

$18 \text{ days} = 24 \times 18 = 432 \text{ hours}$

2. <sup>So, the</sup> 11 days 20 hours.

$1 \text{ day} = 24 \text{ hour}$

$11 \text{ days} = 11 \times 24 \text{ hours} = 264 \text{ hours}$

$11 \text{ days } 20 \text{ hours} = 264 \text{ hour} + 20 \text{ hours} = 284$
