(Q.8) Kabir gets 43 marks in the first test. He gets 35 marks in the second test. How many marks does he get in all?

Ans → Number of marks in first test = 43

Number of marks in second test = 35

Total number of marks = 78

Ans → So, he gets 78 marks in all.

Q.9 If one number is 390 and the other number is 60. What is the sum of these two numbers?

Ans → One number = 390

Other number = + 60

Sum of those two numbers = 450

Ans → So, sum of those two numbers is 450.

Q.10 Lucy went to the grocery store. She bought 12 packs of cookies and 16 packs of noodles. How many packs of groceries did she buy in all?

Ans → Number of pack cookies = 12

Number of pack noodles = + 16

Total groceries = 28

Ans → So, she buy 28 packs of groceries.
