

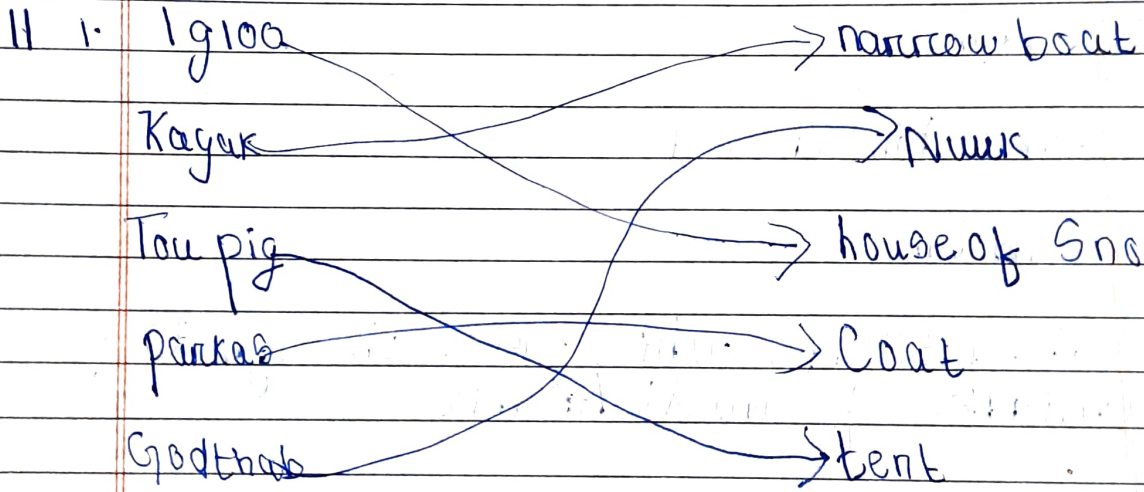
1) Arctic Circle is also called the tundra region.
