

Let us consider another example : Number

T 0
9 0
 0
 9

Here face value of 0 ones
is zero and the face
value of 9 tens = 9.



- Note : (i) For a digit in ones place, place value = face value.
(ii) Place value of a digit = face value \times value of its place.
(iii) The place value and face value of zero is always zero.
