The Constitutional laws are:-

- (i) Dowry Prohibition Act 1961
- (ii) Scheduled Casts and Scheduled Tribes Act 1989
- (iii) Employment of Manual Scavengers and Construction of Dry Latrines (Prohibition) Act, 1993
- (iv) The Bonded Labour System (Abolition) Act, 1976
- (v) Protection of Human Rights Act 1993 (to restore the dignity of human beings)
- (vi) Disabilities Act 1995
- (vii) Mizoram Liquor Total Prohibition Act, 1995
Many such acts have been passed to ensure that the ill treatment of the less privileged does not continue.
