

9) What do you mean by coming together federalism?

Ans- Coming together federalism involves independent States coming together on their own to form a bigger unit, so that by pooling sovereignty and retaining identity they can increase their security.

10) What do you mean by Holding together federalism?

Ans- Holding together federalism is where a large country decides to divide its power between the constituent States and the national government.

11) Define Union List.

Ans- Union List is a list which includes subjects of national importance such as defence, foreign affairs, banking, communications and currency. Central government has the right to make laws.

12) Define State List.

Ans- State List contains subjects of State and local importance such as police, trade, commerce, agriculture and irrigation. State government has the right to make laws.

13) Define Concurrent List.

Ans- Concurrent List includes subjects of common interest to both the Central and State government such as education, forest, trade, unions, marriage, adoption and succession. Both Central as well as State government can make laws.

14) Define Residuary List.

Ans- In Residuary List, the subject which do not fall under Union, State and Concurrent List are residuary subjects. The Central government has the power to make laws.
