

Q.1 Define the term Constitution.

Ans. A constitution is a set of rules, laws and principles according to which a country is governed. The rules and laws are specially created to suit the needs of the people of that country.

Q.2. What are the three organs of the government?

Ans. Executive, Legislature and Judiciary are the three organs of the government.

Q.3. What is meant by Dissent?

Ans. If a law is not satisfied by the people the group of people will protest, do strikes etc this called dissent.

Q.4 What do you mean by rule of law?

Ans. Our constitution established the rule of law in India, i.e. violation of these laws was made punishable and no one was above the law. So if anyone broke the law he or she would be liable to be punished - irrespective of Caste, creed or gender.

Q.5. When can a law be declared as null and void by a court?

Ans. Every law enacted by the legislature has to confirm the provisions of the constitution; otherwise they will be declared as null and void by the court.
