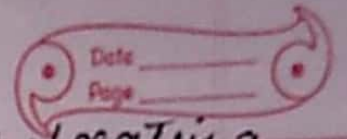

Latitude and Longitude Locating Places on the globe.

1) Notes of latitudes

- * An imaginary line running horizontally across the globe.
- * Lines of latitude (or parallels) are imaginary parallel lines that run horizontally across the globe.
- * The equator is 0° latitude and divides the earth into the northern and southern hemisphere.
- * They are equidistant from each other.

2) Notes of longitudes

- * An imaginary line running vertically around the globe.
- * Lines of longitudes (or meridians) are lines of equal length that run vertically across the globe.
- * Lines of longitudes run from the north pole to the south pole, in a north-south direction. However, they give the east west coordinates of a place.
