

The peace at Versailles with the Allies was a harsh and humiliating peace because Germany lost its overseas colonies, a tenth of its population, 13% of its territories, 75% of its iron and 26% of its coal to France, Poland, Denmark and Lithuania. The Allied powers demilitarised Germany.

- The War Guilt Clause held Germany responsible for the war damages the Allied countries suffered.
- Germany was forced to pay compensation amounting to £6 billion.
