- 1) It was the system of revenue collection, was introduced in Madras and Bombay presidencies between 1792 and 1827 is called as Ryotwari system.

- 3) Mahalwari system, one of the three main revenue systems of land tenure in British India, the other two being zamindari and the individual cultivator.

4) The mahalwazi system was introduced by Holt Mackenzie. It was introduced in Uttar Pradesh, central part of India, the North-west Province and parts of Punjab.

5) ~~The~~ The ryotwazi system, the government got tax from those who cultivated lands with their own hands. In the ryotwazi system the middlemen were removed. This system was better than the Permanent settlement of revenue. It increased the right of the farmers.
