WHAT DOES IT SHOW

Imagine what would happen if farmers refuse to sell sugarcane to a mill. The mill will have to shutdown

This is an example of the secondary being independent on tertiary sector. This is primary

Imagine what would happen if companies decide not to buy cotton from Indian market and export from other countries. Indian cultivation will become less profitable. Cotton prices will fall

All these are cause. This is an example of primary sector which is dependent on secondary sector.

Farmers buy many goods such as tractors, pumps etc. will go up. Cost of cultivation of the farmer will rise and profits are reduced

This is an example of primary sector dependent on secondary sector.

Primary sector is concerned with extraction and production of natural resources
Eg. ✓

Secondary sector is concerned with processing the materials which have already extracted
Eg. ✓ Making jewellery from gold

Tertiary sector it is concerned with providing support to primary and secondary sector
Eg. ✓ Insurance
