Television is a machine with a screen. Television receive broadcasting signals and change them into pictures and sound. The word "television" comes from the word tele (greek for far away) and vision (sight). The television was invented in the 1920s but the equipment was expensive and the pictures were poor. Sometimes a television can look like a box. Older TVs had a large cathode ray tube in a large wooden frame and set on the floor like furniture. Newer TVs are much lighter and flatter.
