### Recap

- Words that describe nouns are called **adjectives**.
- Adjectives that give us information about the quantity or position of a noun (how much/how many/first/second/last) are called **quantitative adjectives**.  
For example, *some, many, few, three*
- Adjectives that describe the quality of a noun (what kind/type) are called **qualitative adjectives**. For example, *sweet, tall, red, pink, naughty, cold*
