

- Words that describe nouns are called adjectives.
- Adjectives that give us information about the quantity or position of a noun (how much/how many/first/second/last) are called quantitative adjectives.
 For example, *some*, *many*, *few*, *three*
- Adjectives that describe the quality of a noun (what kind/type) are called qualitative adjectives. For example, *sweet*, *tall*, *red*, *pink*, *naughty*, *cold*
