## Differences between snow fed rivers and rain fed rivers

### Snow fed rivers / Rain fed rivers

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| 1- The rivers that have started in high mountains from melting ice and snow.                 | 1- The rivers that formed with streams produced by heavy rain on the hill. |
| 2- Example - Satlaj, Chenab and Jhelum   | 2- Example - Godavari, Krishna, Kaveri, Mahanadi.                          |
| 3- During summer snow starts melting and there climate that is neither too hot nor too cold. | 3- They often become dry during the summer.                                |
