Q1. Define glands.

→ Glands are a part of our body that secrete chemical substances, called hormones, in our blood ^{& enzymes}.

Q2. What are the different types of glands.

→ There are two types of glands: Endocrine & Exocrine. Endocrine glands are the glands which doesn't ~~has~~ any ducts & directly secretes the hormones into our blood. Ex: Adernal gland, Pitutary gland.

Exocrine glands are the glands that has ducts & the secretions of these glands are carried by ducts. Ex: saliavary gland, sweat gland & etc.
