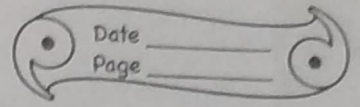

8) State the location of the following in a flower.

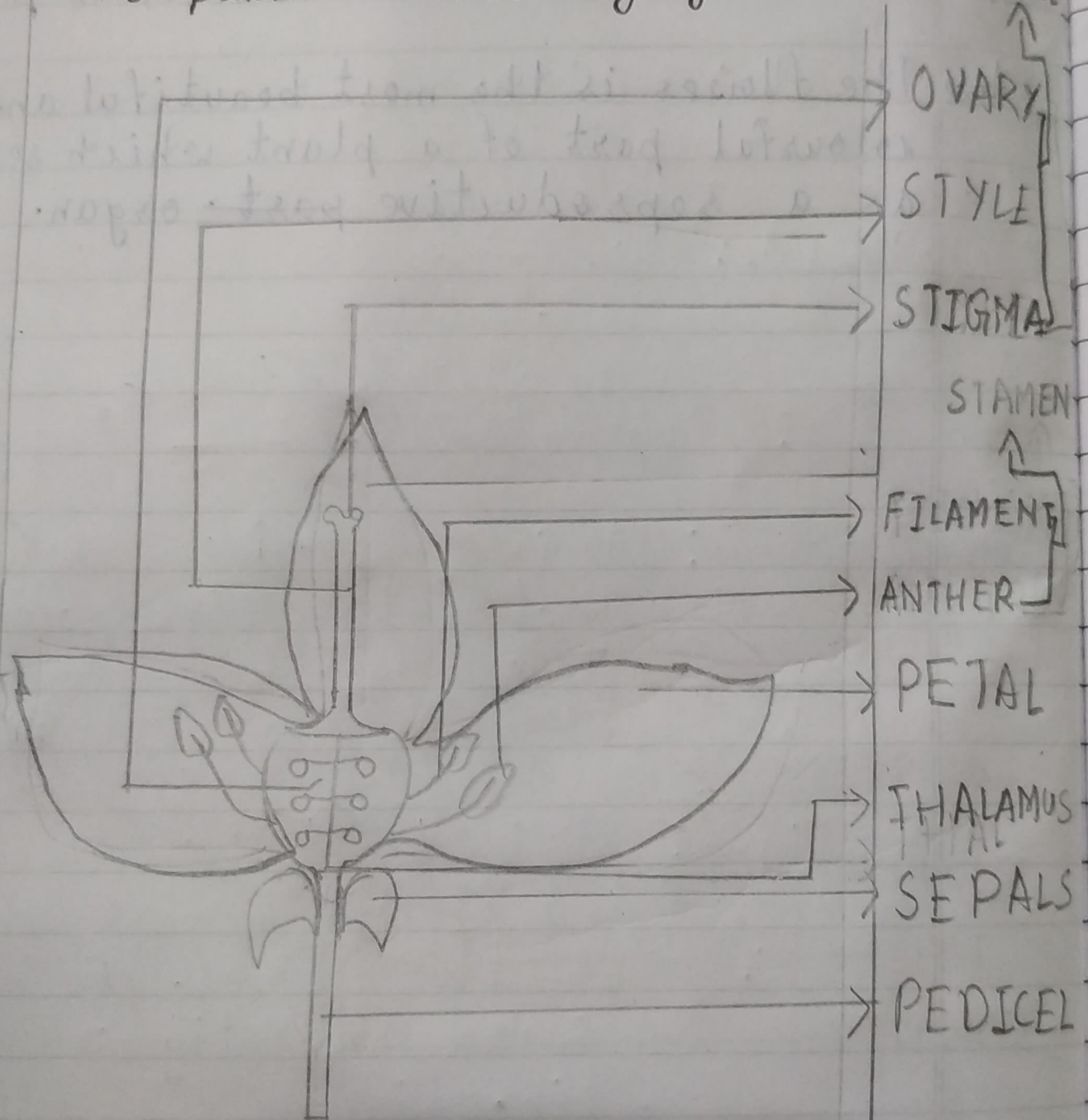
Ans) a) Sepals: Sepals are the green outermost part of the flower.

b) Petals: This forms the second inner whorl. Petals are the large, fragrant and brightly coloured parts of the ~~poem~~ flower.

c) Anthers: It is located in the third whorl of the flower. The filament of the stamen bears the anther at its tip.

d) Stigma: It is located in the fourth and the innermost whorl of the flower. The style bears the stigma at its tip.
