

1. Difference between luminous and non-luminous objects.

Luminous objects

① Objects that can emit their own light are called energy by themselves are known as luminous objects.

Non-luminous objects
① Objects that cannot emit light energy by themselves are known as non-luminous objects.

② These objects can cause the sensation of light.

② These objects do not cause the sensation of light.

③ The luminous objects are visible as they emit light on their own.

③ The non-luminous objects are visible because of luminous objects.

④ The sun and candle are two examples.

④ The moon and two planets are two examples.
