Answer:-

Reasons for 1905 revolution are:-

- The prices of essential goods rose so quickly that real wages of workers were declined by 20%.
- The membership of workers associations rose dramatically.
- Over 11,000 workers in St. Petersburg went on strike demanding a reduction in the working day to 8 hours, an increase in wages & improvement in working conditions.
- The attack on Father Gapon in winter palace by police & assaults in which ~~to~~ ~~at~~ over 100 workers were killed & 300 ~~at~~ about 300 were ~~was~~ wounded. The incident also known as Bloody Sunday, ~~at~~ which ~~is~~ started a series of events that became to be known as the 1905 Revolution.
