→ On the right bank of river Neva workers, quarters & factories were located & the left river bank was a fashionable area where many official buildings were also located.

→ The govt. imposed a curfew on the left bank of river Neva.

→ All demonstrations came back on 24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> February, <sup>1917</sup>. On 25<sup>th</sup> Feb. Duma was suspended.

→ On 26<sup>th</sup> February, demonstrations returned in force to the streets of

~~the~~ left river bank.

→ On 27<sup>th</sup> February, the police headquarters were ransacked.

→ On 28<sup>th</sup> February, workers demonstrated in the streets, raising slogans about bread, wages & democracy.

2) What do you mean by Petrograd Soviet?
