- On the right bank of river Neva workers' quarter & factories were located & the left river bank was a fashionable area where many official buildings were also located.
- The govt. imposed a curfew on the left bank of river Neva.
- All demonstrations came back ~~off~~ ¹⁹¹⁷ on 24th & 25th February. On 25th Feb. Duma was suspended.
- On 26th February, demonstrators returned in force to the streets of

left river bank.

- On 27th February , the police head-quarters were sacked .
- ~~On 28th February~~ . Workers demonstrated in the streets , raising slogan about ~~to~~ bread , wages & ~~to~~ democracy .

2) What do you mean by Petrograd Soviet ?
