

Adaptations for food in different animals

- i. Herbivores :- cows, goats and giraffes, etc are present in this group. They have long and strong legs to travel long distances for searching food. Herbivores are plant eater animals thus they have sharp biting and strong grinding teeth.
- ii. Carnivores :- Flesh eating animals are carnivores. Lions, Tigers,

and dogs etc are in carnivores group. They have well ~~dev~~ developed tearing teeth. Some birds like eagles and vultures are also in carnivores group.

They have sharp beaks and claws to catch other animals and to tear their flesh.

iii Omnivores :- Animals that eat both plants and animals known as omnivores. Bears, crows, and, cockroaches are some

omnivores example .

iv Parasites: = some animals live on or inside the bodies of other animals for their food.

They are called parasites .

Mosquitoes, Leeches, Hookworms and bugs etc are parasites .

They have suckers or sucking tubes to suck blood from their host .
