ans → Sedimentary rocks are types of rocks that are formed by the accumulation or deposition of minerals or organic particles.

→ Sedimentary rocks are deposited in layers as strata, form a structure called bedding. They are often deposited in large structures called Sedimentary Basins.

→ E.g = Sandstone, Limestone, siltstone, shale, etc.
