

The constitution and need for laws

① Define the term constitution.

ans → Constitution is a set of rules, laws and principles according to which a country is governed.

② What are the three organs of Government?

ans → The three organs of a govt. are -

- ✗ Legislature
- ✗ Executive
- ✗ Judiciary

③ What is meant by dissent?

ans → When any law goes against the interests of a group of people, then, the group will protest to express its dissatisfaction known as dissent.

④ What do you mean by rule of law?

ans → Every one is under the rule of constitution and its laws. If there could be any violation against these laws which can be considered as illegal then, the citizen is punishable. Thus the rule of law states that no one is above the

constitution and its laws.

Q When can a law be declared as null and void by a court?

ans → If any law is enacted against the principles of the constitution, then the judiciary has the right to declare it null and void and could abolish it.
