In abacus (a) above, spike T has 5 beads and spike O has 2 beads. Therefore, it represents the number 52. Similarly, in abacus (b) spike T has beads and O has one bead. Hence it represents 41. In abacus (c), spike T has beads and O has 2 beads. Therefore, it represents 32.

Note: 1. Please explain to the children that an abacus has spikes to represent numbers even beyond hundreds.

2. Each spike in an abacus can have maximum 9 beads only.

We know that one more than 9 is 10 and it is represented by 1 bead in spike.

Also, one more than 99 is 100 and it is represented by 1 bead in spike H.
