2. What is the reason behind the sparkling of diamond?
- A diamond sparkles because, when it is held a certain way, the intensity of the light coming from it is greatly enhanced. A ray of light coming from it is greatly enhanced when it strikes a bottom facet of the diamond at an angle of incidence that exceeds the critical angle, θ_c , and are totally reflected back into the diamond, eventually exiting the top surface to give the diamond its sparkle.

3. Biconvex lens will be more converging because it has both sides convex lens but in Plano convex one side is plane and another side is convex lens.
