To meet the expenses of maintaining this huge army, he had to find ways to add to his revenue. He confiscated all the rent-free land holding that had been given to priests & government officials. The officials were forbidden to collect extra taxes from peasants. The peasants paid revenue in kind directly to the state. The land revenue was raised to half the total produce. In this way he was able to build a rich treasury. The Sultan also put a check on the price of commodities, so that the soldiers could live within their income.
