



15. How are the Earth's layers different from each other

Crust	Mantle	Core
* The crust is the uppermost layer of the Earth. It is hewed and made up of rocks, stones, sand, soil.	Mantle is below the crust. It is a very thick layer.	Core is the deepest layer of the Earth and it is very hot lava.
* It is 5 km thick at ocean floor and 35 km thick at continental floor.	It is 2900 km thick. It is hotter than the rock and consists of molten magma.	It is The radius of the core is about 3500 km. It is mostly made of nickel and iron.
* It is divided into 2 parts: upper crust and lower crust.	* It is divided into 2 parts: upper mantle and lower mantle.	* It is divided divided into 2 parts: upper and inner core.
