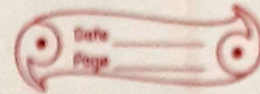

Socialism in Europe & the Russian Revolution

1. Who were liberals, radicals & conservatives?

Liberals was a group of people who wanted a nation which tolerated all religions. They opposed the uncontrolled power of dynastic rule. They wanted to safe guard the rights of individuals against government.
