Q1) What do you mean by coming together federalism?

Independent states coming together on their own to form bigger unit.
Increase security by pooling sovereignty and retaining identity. All constituent states have equal power.

Q2) What do you mean by holding together federalism?

Q3) Define union list?

Q4) Define State List?

It contains subjects of state and local importance such as police, trade, commerce, agriculture and irrigation.

Q5) Define Concurrent List?

It includes subjects which are of common concern both to the centre and the state governments. Both centre and the state governments can frame laws on these subjects.

Q6) Define Residuary List?

Union Government has powers to make laws on Residuary subjects such as ~~the~~ subjects include computer software, e-commerce.
