

Write some of the adaptations of a camel and a Polar bear.

Ans - Adaptations of Camel - Camels are well adapted for survival in the desert. Their adaptations include :- large, flat feet - to spread their weight on the sand, thick fur on the top of the body for shade, and thin fur elsewhere to allow heat loss.

Adaptations of Polar Bear - Their adaptations include :- a white appearance - as camouflage for prey on the snow and ice, thick layers of fat and fur - for insulation against the cold. A small surface area to volume ratio - to minimise heat loss.
