<u>COWS</u> (Herbivores)	Cows are well adapted for grazing with a wide mouth and specialized teeth for eating tough vegetation.
<u>LIONS</u> (Carnivores)	Lions have adapted strong, retractable jaws and rough tongues to help them eat their prey.
<u>BEARs</u> (Omnivores)	Bears have large, padded feet and strong curved claws allow it to climb trees easily to get to fruit, nuts, and honey. They also have a long and sticky tongue.
<u>MOSQUITOES</u> (Parasites)	Female mosquitoes feed on nectar and blood. Blood is necessary for egg development following mating.
