COWS
(Herbivores)

Cows are well adapted for grazing with a wide mouth and specialized teeth for eating tough vegetation.

LIONS
(Carnivores)

Lions have adapted strong, retractable jaws and rough tongues to help them eat their prey.

BEARS
(Omnivores)

Bears have large, padded feet and strong curved claws allow it to climb trees easily to get to fruit, nuts, and honey. They also have a long and sticky tongue.

MOSQUITOES
(Parasites)

Female mosquitoes feed on nectar and blood. Blood is necessary for egg development following mating.
